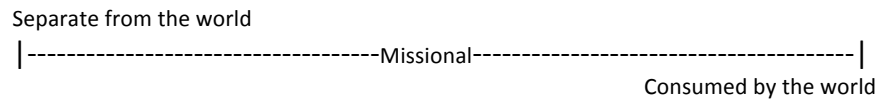
TAKING IT HOME
